## The Essential-but-not-Obvious To-Do List

There are a million details to remember before you head out on a workation. Here's the checklist I use to make sure I have some of those less obvious (but important) ones covered. There are also many blank lines for you to add your own!

Ве	fore You Go
	Called banks and credit card companies to tell them where you're traveling (so they don't assume fraudulent activity when you try to buy a bag of chips in Buenos Aires)
	Redirected mail (see here for more details)
	Researched health insurance coverage in workation destination
	Removed all-but-minimum car insurance (saves \$\$)
	Put house internet and cable on hold (saves \$\$)
	Called your mobile phone carrier and figured out international phone usage. Should you get an international plan, pay as needed, or just rely on free Wi-Fi?
	Security system/plans in place
	Have scheduled someone to regularly check on the house and check mailbox in case something slips through post office
	Put garbage/recycle pick-up on hold
	Ordered extra prescriptions to take with
	If needed, got an International Driving Permit ( <u>see AAA</u> )
	Gave valuables to family member so they're not in your house while you're gone
	Exchanged a small amount of cash so you have \$25-\$100 in foreign currency before you leave
	Put local newspaper delivery on hold (nothing says "I'm not home, please rob me" like a pile of newspapers at your front door)
То	Take with You
	Hard copies of all of your travel documents, including confirmations for your housing, work space, and directors for getting from the airport to your home. Don't assume your phone will work or connect once you land!
	Contact name and number for your housing
	Contact name and number for nanny agency or school
	Contact name and number for nanny
	Name, number and address of nearest hospital
	Name, number and address of nearest clinic
	Name, number of any local friends or friends of friends, in case of emergency
